RPC23-32 Zoning Bylaw Amendment & Discretionary Use – 1876 Wallace Street – PL202300142

#### **Recommendation**

Regina Planning Commission recommends that City Council:

- Approve the discretionary use application for the proposed "Assembly, Religious" at 1876 Wallace Street, legally described as Lots 21-24, Block 4, Plan G384, subject to compliance with the following development standards and conditions:
  - a. The development shall be generally consistent with the plans attached to this report as Appendix A.3, prepared by MEWS Corporation.
  - b. Except otherwise specified in this approval, the development shall comply with all applicable standards and regulations in the *Regina Zoning Bylaw, 2019.*
- 2. Approve amendments to the Regina Zoning Bylaw, 2019, Chapter 3,

to delete the following sub-clause from Clause 1 of Row T2.4, Table 3A.T2; Row T2.4, Table 3B.T2; Row T2.4, Table 3C.T2; Row T2.4, Table 3D.T2; Row T2.3, Table 3E.T2; and Row T2.4, Table 3F.T2:

- "(b) shall be located only on sites adjoining and accessed by a collector or arterial street."
- 3. Instruct the City Solicitor to prepare the necessary bylaw(s) to give effect to the recommendations.
- 4. Approve these recommendations at its meeting on December 6, 2023.
