Recommendation

 - a) The development shall be generally consistent with the plans attached to this report as Appendix A-3.1 and A-3.5 submitted by Lane Arthur Architecture Ltd dated July 2018.
 - b) The development shall comply with all applicable standards and regulations in *Regina Zoning Bylaw No. 9250*.
