

## **Adapted Recreation Plan - Preliminary Report**

## RECOMMENDATION

That City Council:

- 1. Approve \$375,000 in ongoing funding be brought forward in the 2022 budget process for final discussion for the following:
  - \$145,000 for an Inclusion Support Program that will provide one-on-one support to people with disabilities and their families who are accessing City-run recreation and leisure opportunities
  - \$200,000 to maintain the Adapted Sport and Recreation funding stream of the Community Investment Grants Program that was launched in 2021
  - \$30,000 through the 2022 budget process toward training for all existing recreation staff in disability and inclusion.
- 2. Delegate authority to the City Manager to adjudicate, approve and administer the Adapted Sport and Recreation Funding stream of the Community Investment Grants Program.
- 3. Delegate authority to the City Manager to approve a funding agreement with the Government of Canada should the City's application to the Government of Canada's Enabling Accessibility Fund be successful.

## HISTORY

At the September 15, 2021 meeting of the Community Wellness Committee, the Committee considered the attached CWC21-10 report from the City Planning & Community Development Division.

Alex Mohrbutter, representing South Saskatchewan Independent Living Centre, addressed the Committee.

The Committee adopted a resolution to concur in the recommendation contained in the report.

Recommendation #4 in the attached report does not require City Council approval.
