RECOMMENDATION

That City Council:

1. Approve \$375,000 in ongoing funding be brought forward in the 2022 budget process for final discussion for the following:
 - \$145,000 for an Inclusion Support Program that will provide one-on-one support to people with disabilities and their families who are accessing City-run recreation and leisure opportunities
 - \$200,000 to maintain the Adapted Sport and Recreation funding stream of the Community Investment Grants Program that was launched in 2021
 - \$30,000 through the 2022 budget process toward training for all existing recreation staff in disability and inclusion.
2. Delegate authority to the City Manager to adjudicate, approve and administer the Adapted Sport and Recreation Funding stream of the Community Investment Grants Program.
3. Delegate authority to the City Manager to approve a funding agreement with the Government of Canada should the City's application to the Government of Canada's Enabling Accessibility Fund be successful.

HISTORY

At the September 15, 2021 meeting of the Community Wellness Committee, the Committee considered the attached CWC21-10 report from the City Planning & Community Development Division.


Alex Mohrbutter, representing South Saskatchewan Independent Living Centre, addressed the Committee.
