Re: Smoking and Vaping in Public Places

WHEREAS the City of Regina has deferred to provincial legislation as it pertains to smoking issues since *The Tobacco Control Act* was passed in 2015.

WHEREAS there has been increased interest in expanding the city's current smoking bylaw to include more outdoor spaces, including restaurant and bar patios.

WHEREAS other Saskatchewan communities have updated their bylaws to exceed the restrictions in *The Tobacco Control Act*, including limitations on "vaping" and e-cigarettes.

WHEREAS Council members would like to begin a review of Regina's Bylaw No. 10167 to ensure it is up to date and reflects community expectations and standards.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Administration prepare public consultation process to be completed by April 1, 2017 to determine the level of public interest in extending Bylaw No. 10167 to:

- Restrict smoking in public places, including restaurant and bar patios, playgrounds, fixed seats or bleachers in public venues, sports fields, outdoor concerts or public gatherings on municipal property
- Restrict "vaping" or e-cigarette use in public places, including restaurant and bar patios, playgrounds, fixed seats or bleachers in public venues, sports fields, outdoor concerts or public gatherings on municipal property
