
## **Appendix C**

## **Broad Leaf Weeds in Turf**

**Use**: Primarily used for dandelion, thistle, plantain control. May also be used for a few regulated noxious weeds like such as spotted Knapweed.

**Product used**: 2,4 D based products – some variances on this (salts). Most commonly known as Killiex, Trillion or Weed'n Feed.



Note – this chart is based on park space hectare and excludes golf courses. Pest Control would be the primary user of this product usage with a few exceptions over time.

## Non-selective weed control

**Use**: To kill any plant material around fence lines, poplar roots damaging structures (after root prune barrier installation), hard surfaces, aggregate surfaces, warning tracks. May also be used in turf for specific weeds that will not succumb to 2,4 d in turf – turf would be killed at same time.

**Product used**: Glyphosate - Most commonly known as Round or Vantage.

Chart 1 – total use per year.




Chart 2- Glyphosate - Break down By User Group (Last 5 years - mass Kg)




Chart 3 – glyphosate break down by work unit as percentage previous two years.
