What follows is a quick summary of the important points I wish to speak about.

- The importance of queer specific funding streams, and the demonstrated need for funding that we see year round from our community.
- The importance of the City's stance as a Queer and Trans affirming employer, and how it relates to breaking down the stigma and discrimination that the 2SLGBTQIAP+ community faces in Regina.
- How vital it is to include voices from the Queer and Trans communities in decisions, policies, and systems that affect them.
- How our work here at UR Pride demonstrates, daily, the need for our city to improve the day-to-day material conditions of 2SLGBTQIAP+ people's lives.
- To assert that our community is undeniably a significant population within the City of Regina, and that we deserve to exist within systems that are designed in ways that support our lives.
