I have recently been made aware of the proposed bylaw that would prevent opening, moving or expanding activity centers in industrial areas. As a family of 5, with my wife, three kids and I, who are all very active, we make use of these facilities on a regular basis. A few that come to mind are CrossFit Iron Society, Gymnastics Adventures, Regina Climbing Centre, Get Air Trampoline Park, etc.

My concern is that if we prevent these facilities from operating in industrial areas and force them into strip malls or residential areas it will increase the businesses costs, limit the services they can offer or even prevent them from operating at all. This will also drive membership prices up which will limit or in some cases likely prevent our family from participating in these activities.

Without some assurance or ability to know that these changes won't impact our fit and healthy lifestyle I would ask that you reconsider these changes.
