THE COMMUNITY NON-PROFIT TAX EXEMPTION AMENDMENT BYLAW, 2019

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REGINA ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 The purpose of this Bylaw is to provide a tax exemption for an additional property under the City’s Community Non-Profit Tax Exemption Policy.
- 2 Bylaw 2019-63 being *The Community Non-Profit Tax Exemption Bylaw, 2019* is amended in the manner set forth in this Bylaw.
- 3 The following section is added after section 5:
 - “5.1 Regina Trades and Skills Inc. is exempted from payment of property tax payable by an occupant for the land and improvements located at 1275 Albert Street, Lot 22, Block 145, Plan 94R44318.”
- 4 This Bylaw comes into force on January 1, 2020.
