BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE CLOSURE OF A PORTION OF OSLER STREET
BETWEEN 11TH AVENUE AND SASKATCHEWAN DRIVE

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REGINA ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 The purpose of this Bylaw is to close a portion of the road right-of-way.
- 2 The authority for this Bylaw is section 13 of *The Cities Act*.
- 3 The lane described as a portion of Osler Street and as shown in Appendix "A" is closed.
- 4 This Bylaw comes into force on the day of passage.

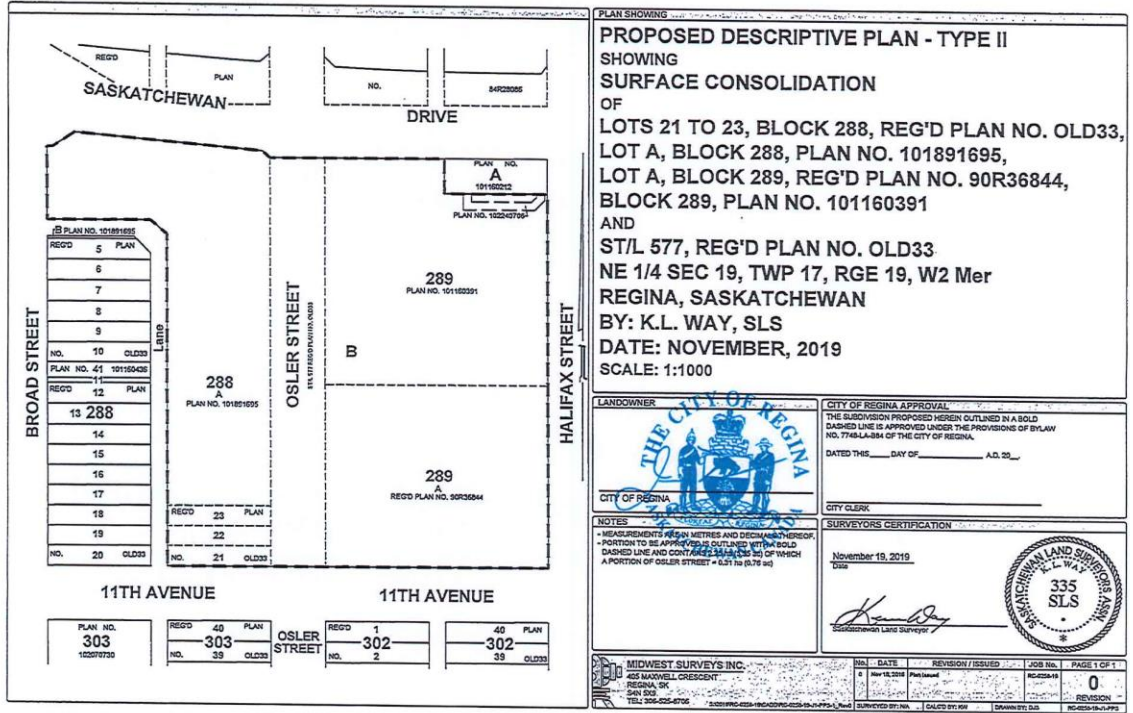
