Please be advised that I will submit the following NOTICE of MOTION at the May 27, 2020 meeting of City Council:

Re: Fencing Setback Regulations

WHEREAS section 69 of *The Traffic Bylaw, Bylaw No. 9900* states that no person shall obstruct sightlines at the intersection of a street with any other street, alley, driveway within the limits as shown in the attached Schedule “H(1)”;

WHEREAS schedule H(2) of *The Traffic Bylaw, Bylaw No. 9900* states that the minimum setback for fences and other obstructions, from a “curb only to no sidewalk”, must be measured from the back of the curb to a minimum distance of 2.0 metres to the fence or other obstructions; and

WHEREAS the regulations set out in *The Traffic Bylaw, Bylaw No. 9900* states that the minimum setback for fences and other obstructions, from a “Sidewalk with curb”, is only required to be measured from the back of the sidewalk to a minimum distance of 0.6 metres to the fence or other obstructions;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that City Council:

1. Direct the Administration to prepare a report for the next Public Works and Infrastructure Committee that outlines any potential implications to amend ‘Schedule H2’ of *The Traffic Bylaw, Bylaw No. 9900* as follows:
 - a. set the minimum setback measurement for fences and other obstructions, “From Curb Only – No Sidewalk” from 2.0 metres to 0.6 metres; and
 - b. that if approved, the City Solicitor prepare the necessary amending bylaw, for this to take effect immediately; and

2. Authorize the suspension of all current pending non-compliance violations or orders to comply until the above noted report and potential amending bylaw has been considered by City Council.
