Please be advised that I will submit the following NOTICE of MOTION at the June 30, 2020 meeting of City Council and that I will seek unanimous consent that this Motion be heard as a matter of urgent business at the same meeting:

Re: Public Complaints Commission – Civilian Oversight; Community Policing
and Community Safety and Well-being

WHEREAS the Regina Board of Police Commissioners adopted P20-14, Public Complaints Commission – Civilian Oversight, attached for reference as Appendix A, and P20-15, attached for reference as Appendix B, at a meeting of the Board held on June 25, 2020;

WHEREAS P20-14 resolved that The Regina Board of Police Commissioners request that the Minister of Justice/Attorney General and the Government of Saskatchewan commit to further reform of the Public Complaints Commission by, inter alia, transitioning to civilian-only oversight, and by creating a civilian-only Independent Serious Incident Response Team;

WHEREAS P20-15 resolved that the Regina Board of Police Commissioners provide to City Council and members of the public certain information including, inter alia, information and analysis on activities of the Regina Police Service on activities related to Community Policing;

WHEREAS P20-15 also resolved that The Board of Police Commissioners advocate to the Provincial Government funding to ensure that those in crisis are receiving proper support and to further the process of integrating response systems to improve community safety and well-being;

WHEREAS both of the above motions, in their preambles, provide cogent justification for the resolutions that they contain; and

WHEREAS this motion is a matter of urgency given that the Legislature of the Province of Saskatchewan is currently considering reforms to the Provincial Complaints Commission and is due to prorogue on July 3, 2020 with dissolution expected in the autumn of 2020;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Regina City Council:

1. Support Regina Board of Police Commissioners motions P20-14 and P20-15 in their entirety; and
2. Urge the implementation of the resolutions contained in the said motions by the Minister of Justice/Attorney General, the Government of Saskatchewan and the Regina Board of Police Commissioners.


