

BYLAW NO. 2020-74

THE REGINA ADMINISTRATION AMENDMENT BYLAW, 2020 (No. 3)

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REGINA ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 The purpose of this Bylaw is to amend Schedule A of Bylaw 2003-69, being *The Regina Administration Bylaw* to establish a COVID-19 Recovery Reserve.
- 2 The authority for this Bylaw is section 8 of *The Cities Act*.
- 3 Schedule A of Bylaw 2003-69, being *The Regina Administration Bylaw* is amended in the manner set forth in this Bylaw.
- 4 The following sections are added after section 38 of Schedule A:

“Purpose and Funding source for the COVID-19 Recovery Reserve

- 39(1) The purpose of the COVID-19 Recovery Reserve is to provide funding for expenditures related to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- (2) The COVID-19 Recovery Reserve shall be funded primarily through any unused funding provided to the City pursuant to the Federal Government’s Safe Re-Start Program.

Covid-19 Recovery Reserve

- 39.1 The account balance for the COVID-19 Recovery Reserve shall include the account balance of the reserve at the start of the year adjusted by:
 - (a) a transfer to the reserve of any unused funding provided to the City pursuant to the Federal Government’s Safe Re-Start Program;
 - (b) transfers from the reserve to fund expenditures related to the COVID-19 pandemic as approved by Council by resolution, bylaw or in the City’s budget, or approved by the City Manager in accordance with this Bylaw.”
