Dear Mr. Nicol:

I am writing in response to the City of Regina's request to have Saskatchewan Housing Corporation (SHC) present to the Mayor's Housing Commission. Dianne Baird, Executive Director of Housing Network is pleased to speak to the Mayor's Housing Commission on Thursday, January 8, 2015 to discuss SHC's programs and initiatives.

SHC owns almost 3,100 rental units in Regina and provides subsidy to more than 2,300 non-profit units. In addition, the Government of Saskatchewan provides rental housing supplements to more than 3,100 households in Regina. This supplement is available to low-income families and persons with a disability to assist in covering the costs of their rent.

The Province of Saskatchewan also offers numerous initiatives to encourage the development of additional housing supply and to assist in the development of affordable housing. Since November 2007, Provincial housing initiatives have committed more than \$94.7 million to develop more than 2,600 housing units that are either completed or under construction. In addition, SHC's repair programs have committed more than \$7.3 million since November 2007, to assist in the development of 550 housing units occupied by low- and modest-income households.


