

## THE HOMES HOUSING FIRST PROGRAM HELPS REGINA'S MOST VULNERABLE RESIDENTS

Since HOMES began, 49 people have been housed and supported



program inception through 2016

23% drop in acuity across fifteen life domains as measured by SPDAT Re-housing people 35 times (less than once per person) ensured that only 4%

returned to homelessness

97% still housed at 6 months, 59% in their original unit



85% involved in community events

(social, recreational and cultural activities)

average between housing search and unit location

100% accessed provincial social assistance



received disability benefits

7 years + 9 months people's average length of homelessness prior to being housed, a combined total 378 years of homelessness
