

OCP Amendment – Harbour Landing West – PL201900072

I am Kevin Filteau, Director of Capital Projects, Ministry of SaskBuilds and Procurement, I am joined today by Rory Jensen, Assistant Deputy Ministry of Education, as well as Adam Hicks, Regina Public School Board Trustee and Sean Chase, Director of Education with Regina Catholic School Board and Vicky Bonnell, Regina Catholic Board Chair. I’d like Adam to speak at this time on behalf of Regina Public.

(Adam Hicks – Regina Public) “Regina Public has an immediate and pressing need to address the current and future school enrolment in this area of the city for our school division. The partners have worked with the City and landowners for two years in compliance with legislation, regulations, the Official Community Plan and school planning guidelines. I will now allow Vicky to speak on behalf of Regina Catholic”

(Vicky Bonnell – Regina Catholic) “Regina Catholic has had to modify the existing facility within Harbour Landing to accommodate the growth experienced since our school doors opened in 2017. There is no more space for the students, which highlights the importance of approving a school site for the new school in Harbour Landing. Based on the immediate needs we collectively face, the recommended option is acceptable to us, although our preference would be for either Option 1 or 2 as this would facilitate a quicker build of the joint use school.”
