THE FORESTRY AMENDMENT BYLAW, 2021

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REGINA ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

Purpose

- 1 The purpose of this Bylaw is to authorize the Director to permit residents to plant public trees as part of the tree donation program, make housekeeping amendments related to outdated position titles and increase the minimum removal fee for requests to remove established trees to \$500 per tree.

Statutory Authority

- 2 The authority for this Bylaw is section 8 of *The Cities Act*.

Bylaw 2002-48 amended

- 3 Bylaw 2002-48, being *The Forestry Bylaw, 2002* is hereby amended in the manner set forth in this Bylaw.

Position Titles

- 4 In section 1, the definition of “Director” is repealed and the following definition is substituted:

“**Director**” means the Director of Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services or the Director’s designate.

- 5 In section 1, the definition of “Executive Director” is repealed and the following definition is substituted:

“**Executive Director**” means the Executive Director, City Planning and Community Development or the Executive Director’s designate.

- 6 In subsection 4(2) “Transportation and Utilities, or his or her designate” is struck out and “Citizen Services or designate” is substituted.

Fee Update

- 7 Clause 3(7)(b) is amended by striking out “\$300” and substituting “\$500”.

Tree Donation Program

- 8 The following subsection is added after subsection 4(2):

- (3) Notwithstanding 4(1)(a), (b) and (c) the Director may authorize any person to plant and maintain a Public Tree subject to the terms and conditions of the
