

Appendix G: Public Education Campaign:

Administration's recommendation to create, implement and fund a Public Education Program will increase understanding of best practices for community safety. These practices are already used by the City and would include:

| <b>Best Practice</b>  | <b>Why</b>   |
|---|--|
| No liquid treatment/spraying of any chemical liquid spray outdoors when winds exceed 25km/hour. | Reduces drifting of liquid sprays into unwanted spaces caused by winds.  |
| No spraying within 50 meters of waterbody (ex: creek or storm water retention pond).            | Reflective of existing provincial regulations where a permit is otherwise required to protect aquatic ecosystems downstream. |
| No spraying within 50 meters of playground structure.   | Minimize impact an area known for passive play.  |
| Personal protective equipment that should be worn during spraying.                              | General education about the safe use and handling.   |
