Why do we spray?

The City monitors insect populations to see if numbers exceed tolerable thresholds. Too many insects can stress trees causing major damage and in some cases death.

What product do we use?

We use an organic product that contains *Bacillus thuringiensis var kurstaki* (BTK). Once ingested by pests, the insect larvae stop feeding and die. It is non-toxic to pets, wildlife and humans. It is approved for use and regulated by Health Canada's Pest Management Regulatory Agency.

I was parked near a tree being sprayed. How do I safely remove the residue from my car?

This product is not a chemical and does not harm your car's finish. You can simply give it a good wash.

PLEASE NOTE:

All spray activities are subject to weather conditions. The City will not spray in the rain or if wind speeds exceed 25 km per hour. **If a weather delay lasts longer than 48 hours, spraying will be rescheduled and you will receive a new notice at that time.**
