THE REGINA ANIMAL AMENDMENT BYLAW, 2023

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REGINA ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 The purpose of this Bylaw is to amend Bylaw 2009-44, being *The Regina Animal Bylaw, 2009* to change the renewal terms for animal licenses.
- 2 The authority for this Bylaw amendment is subsections 8(1), 8(2), and 8(3) of *The Cities Act*.
- 3 Bylaw 2009-44, being *The Regina Animal Bylaw, 2009*, is amended in the manner set forth in this Bylaw.
- 4 Subsection 10(2) is repealed and the following substituted:
 “10(2) A licence issued under this Bylaw shall expire:
 - (a) where issued prior to January 1, 2024, on December 31st of the year in which it was issued.
 - (b) where issued after December 31, 2023, twelve (12) months from the date of issuance.”
- 5 This Bylaw comes into force on the day of passage.

PURPOSE:	To improve licensing renewal terms for residents and reduce City inefficiencies.
ABSTRACT:	This Bylaw amendment changes the renewal period for all licenses issued after December 31, 2023 to have them expire 12 months from the date of purchase rather than at the end of the calendar year as previously required.
