Commissioner's Biography

Mr. Langgard holds a Bachelor of Arts degree with distinction from the University of Regina, a Bachelor of Laws degree from the University of Saskatchewan and a Master of Public Administration degree from the Johnson Shoyama School of Public Policy at the University of Regina.

Mr. Langgard was admitted to the bar in 1981 and currently works in private practice at Gates & Company in Regina.
