Appendix C

Definitions

The City of Regina has established several definitions related to adult services in the *Zoning Bylaw:*

- ADULT ARCADE"- an establishment where, for any form of consideration, one or more
 motion picture projectors, slide projectors, or similar machines for viewing by five or fewer
 persons each are used to show films, motion pictures, video cassettes, slides or other
 photographic reproductions that are characterized by an emphasis upon the depiction or
 description of specified sexual activities or specified anatomical areas.
- "ADULT ENTERTAINMENT" live entertainment including strip-tease and wet clothing contests or similar adult performances as permitted in accordance with the *Alcohol Control Regulations*
- "ADULT ENTERTAINMENT ESTABLISHMENT" a building or part of a building that features live adult entertainment
- "ADULT RETAIL OUTLET/BOOKSTORE" an establishment with the principal purpose to offer for sale or rent, for any form of consideration, any of the following: (a) books, magazines, periodicals, or other printed matter, or photographs, films, motion pictures, video cassettes, slides, or other visual representations that are characterized by an emphasis upon the depiction or description of specified sexual activities or specified anatomical areas; or (b) instruments, devices, or paraphernalia, that are designed for use in connection with sexual activities
- "ADULT MOTION PICTURE THEATRE" an establishment where, for any form of consideration, films, motion pictures, video cassettes, slides, or other photographic reproductions are shown which are characterized by an emphasis on the depiction or description of specified sexual activities or specified anatomical areas.
- "MASSAGE PARLOUR" an establishment where, for any form of consideration, massage is administered to the human body for sexual pleasure; and which is characterized by an emphasis on the depiction or description of specified anatomical areas or specified sexual activities.
- "PERSONAL SERVICE ESTABLISHMENT" a business where professional or personal services are provided for gain and where the retailing of goods, wares, merchandise, articles or things is only accessory to the provision of such services, including the following: (a) barber shops; (b) beauty shops; (c) tailor shops; (d) laundry or dry cleaning shops; (e) shoe repair shops; but not including any use specifically defined or mentioned in this Bylaw, or any use that includes tattoo application services as an accessory use.
