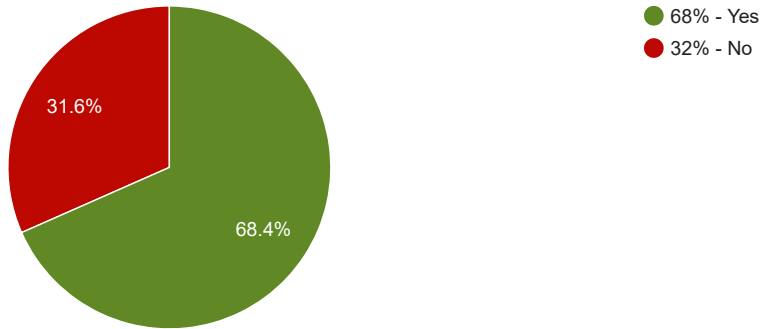

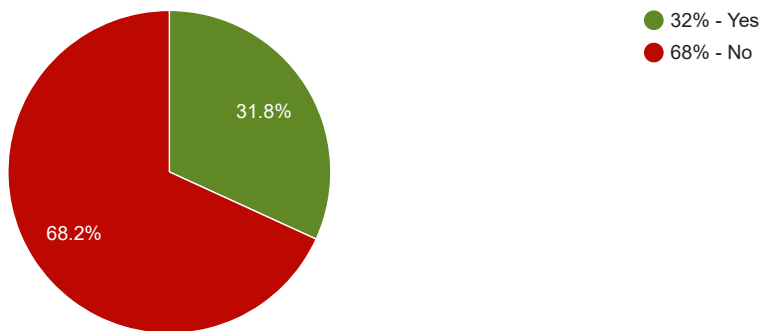

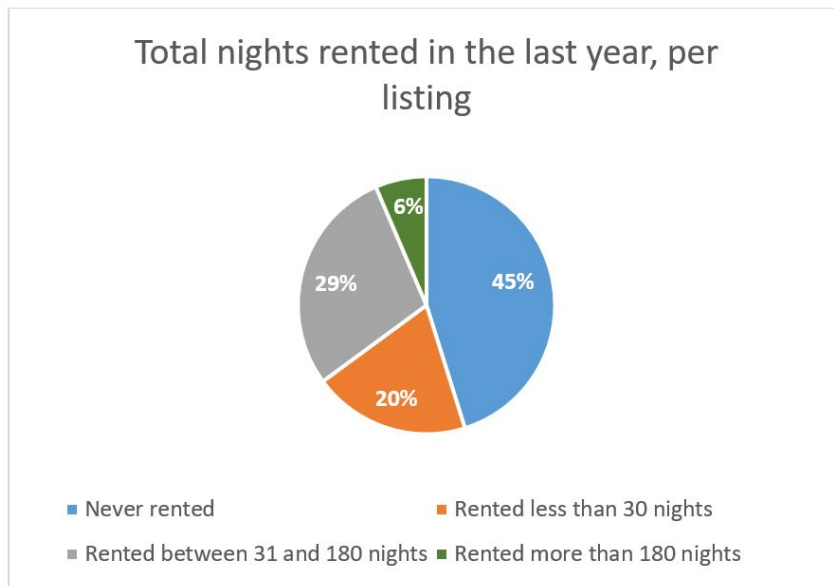
#### 1. Have you ever used a short-term rental service such as Airbnb or VRBO?

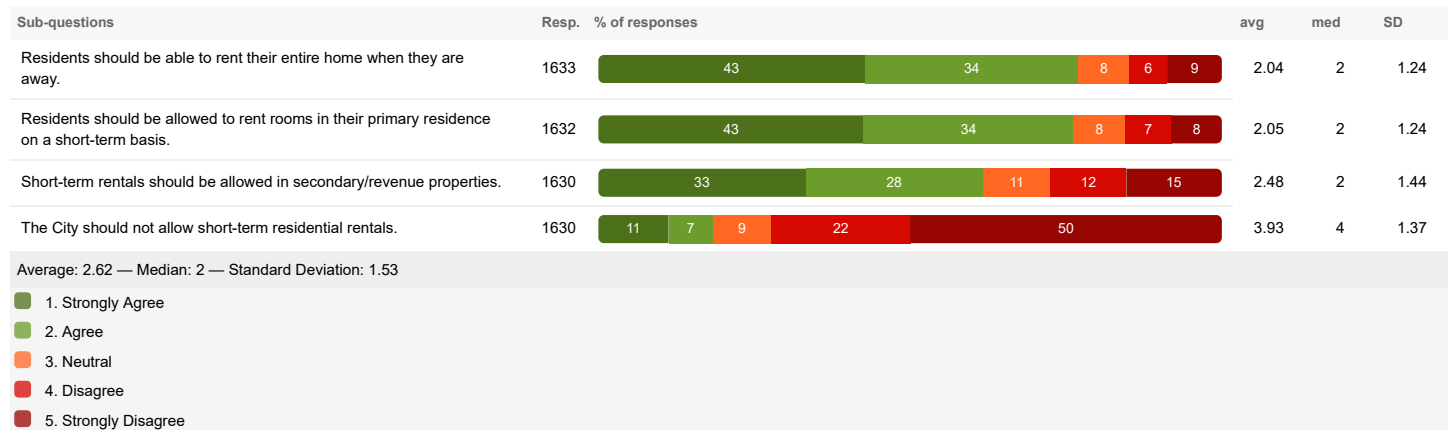

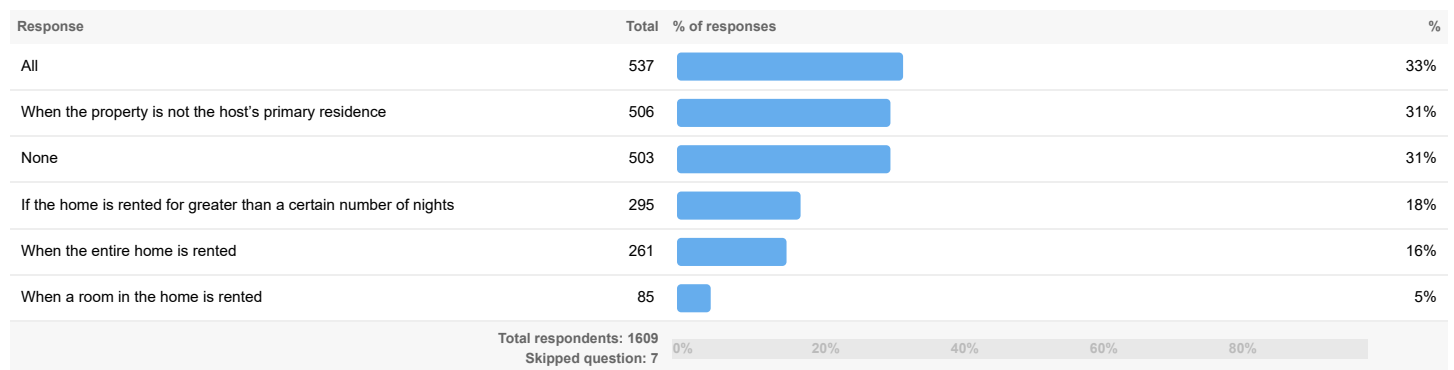

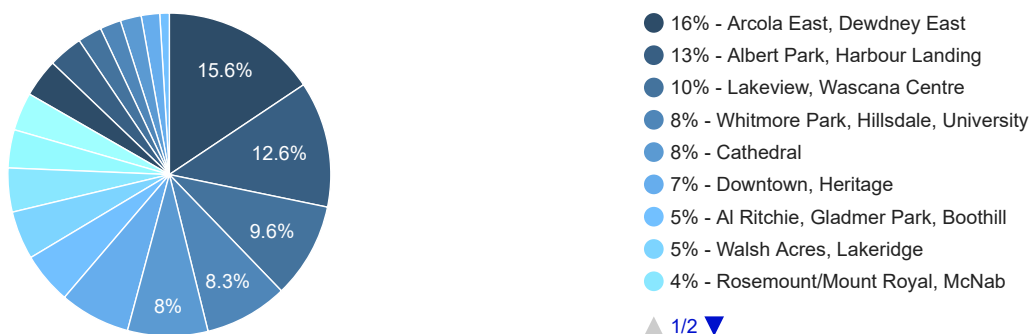


5. The City is exploring options to require a licence for all or some types of short-term rentals.
