

## **APPENDIX B – SIDEWALK CLASSIFICATION**

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The Concrete Inspection and Maintenance Policy recognizes that completing full-city pedestrian counts is costly and labour intensive. Instead, a Group A/B system that recognizes that some locations will have higher user volumes compared to others is utilized. Through this system, priority levels of concrete repairs to sidewalks, curbs, gutters and medians are established. According to the Policy, a Group A Sidewalks are sidewalks that are:

- Adjacent to the following zone designations from The Regina Zoning Bylaw:
  - Residential – R6, R4A, C and TAR
  - Commercial – LC3, DSC, MAC, D, MS and MAC3
  - Institutional – Hospitals, Public and Separate Schools
- Adjacent to church or synagogue properties irrespective of zone designation
- Adjacent to senior housing complex properties that have twenty or more living units irrespective of the zone designation
- At selected locations on Street Priority 1 or 2 streets (based on the City's Winter Road Maintenance Program) that connect larger concentrations of zones designations identified above
- In easements which are within three hundred lineal meters of any other Group A sidewalk

Group B sidewalks are all other sidewalks in the city that are not classified as Group A Sidewalks.
